Dance Guidelines

- Classes are based on a mixture of age and ability. Dancers returning from last year are suggested to refer to the attached recommendations when selecting their classes. Any new dancer may select a class based on descriptions and their best judgment with the understanding that they may be suggested to move to a different class in the first couple weeks. Any questions regarding class placement may be sent to Michele Short, dance coordinator, at danceymca@altavistaymca.com
- The class times and days are subject to change in the first couple weeks due to class sizes. You will be notified if any changes are made prior to the first week of class via the email address provided
- Dance attire for 3 to 5 year old's are leotards and tights, all older dancers should wear t-shirts and yoga pants. If in a ballet class, **ballet shoes should be pink leather**. If in a **tap or jazz class, shoes should be black**. Students in **lyrical may wear ballet shoes or nude toe undies**. Students in **Hip-hop may wear tennis shoes or black jazz shoes**
- Dancers will **NOT** be permitted to enroll in a Lyrical Hip-hop class unless they are simultaneously enrolled in a Ballet Jazz class. This has been a suggestion in the past, but **will** be enforced this year
- Any behavioral issues will be addressed with the parent/parents and must be resolved if the child is to continue dancing
- Please note that if Campbell County Schools are closed for any reason, there will be **NO** dance classes that day

Rarely will handouts be given out during class; All information will be conveyed via email. This includes class cancelations and recital information. For this reason, it is vital that your registration form include a valid email address that is checked daily.

Additionally, we are requesting that any feedback you have for us, both positive and negative, be sent via email throughout the dance season to ensure that times, which are designated for rehearsals are used to benefit the dancers.

If writing to your child's instructor about a specific class question, please put your instructors name in the subject line to ensure an accurate and timely response.
